



Used in formwork construction, filmed plywood is a product made of veneer sheets glued with special adhesive to withstand a high humidity environment, having applied on both sides of the phenolic film film.

Can be manufactured with a non-slip face, ideal for cladding the interior decks of trucks, ships or special platforms.

The wood essences used for the core: poplar or birch. When cutting the plates, the edges will be protected against moisture.

Tego poplar essence.

The faces are covered with, 1m phenolic Stora Enso brown, glossy, 120 g / m<sup>2</sup>.

Adhesive type: WBP - moisture resistant adhesive

Quality classes: CEMENTPLEX (top quality); STANDARD

Use: 10 - 15 formwork cycles (valid for correct handling of the tiles) for poplar essence and 30 cycles for birch.
